

**National Status: Endangered, Scarce, Archaeophyte****NERC S41****UK BAP Priority Species****S Hants: Rare**

Archaeophyte

At Damerham it was noted as "Common in Damerham area" in the 1950s by the Hampshire Field Club. In 1991 only one (unlocalised) plant was found there. It was also recorded at Owslebury (SU52) in 1834 and at Fort Purbrook, Portsdown (SU60T or SU60Y) in 1910.

Much declined due to agricultural methods, and probably only hanging on now at two sites. Some sites with only pre-1987 records are detailed to encourage further search. Many old records cannot be assigned to better than tetrad or even 10km level. Examples are Nine Mile Water Farm, Broughton (SU33C) in 1938; Nether Wallop Aerodrome (SU33E) in 1968; E of Sutton Scotney (SU43P) in c.1958; Weeke (SU43Q) in 1826; Freefolk Wood cornfield (SU44X) in 1958; Ovington Field near Matterley Farm (SU52P) in 1770 and Selborne (SU73) in 1768.
