Neophyte

All recent VC12 sites are the garden form *ptarmicifolia*. The native form *bulbifera* probably still occurs just 1km beyond the VC12 border in West Sussex at Hill Brow SU801262, where shown to ARGM by FR. A record for a “small copse near Preston Candover” in 1879 may have been the native form, though the 1996 *Flora* judges this as unlikely as it is geographically isolated from the plant’s accepted native range.
