I have omitted some earlier records, or duplicates, with the same grid reference.

The grid refs given as SU248405 are south of the railway so inaccurate, from the BAP41 sketch maps it is clear that the plants are north of the railway and beside the Portway track, SU253409 for Field A and SU250408 for Field B. There is possibly parking at SU2586 4137 for those fields and might be able to head north on another track
