

Galium pumilum, 1990-2023, at least 6 fig grid ref **Best to Search: early June - late August**

Yellow highlighting is for sites I favour visiting first

Site Name	Gridref	Date	Comment
Ladle Hill	SU47675673	13-Jul-23	Still present at SU47670 56739, on a steep slope at the base of a Ragwort on an animal track. Only occupying 15 square centimetres and flowers gone over, so not easy to find.
Ladle Hill	SU47675673	09-Jul-21	The patch reported in 2019 and 2020 at c. SU47670 56738 is still present although perhaps less vigorous.
Ladle Hill	SU47675673	06-Jun-20	One plant re-found at SU47671 56738.
Ladle Hill	SU47665673	07-Jul-19	One diffuse patch/plant occupying c. 30 square centimetres at SU47669 56738. Sample taken for DNA testing in case it is <i>Galium fleurotii</i> .
Ladle Hill	SU476567	10-Jul-11	Specimen in Hb.ARG.M. Single patch 50cm x 20cm at SU4767 5673 beside a minor trampled animal track on a very steep slope close to the woodland / scrub edge. Despite much searching in this area west of the ancient earthworks, and on the banks of the earthworks itself, we could only find this single patch. [Not re-found here when searched by A R G Mundell on 7 July 2017, but the scrub edge has not encroached and the spot looks unchanged and still has suitable habitat.]
