Church Crookham Churchyard	SU807518	12-Oct-18	Two plants one of them in flower on raised bank of sparse vegetation at SU8077 5184. It has spread here from its stronghold on the other side of the entrance path from the lych gate.
Longmoor Airstrip	SU809316	01-Jan-97	a little further west'. [W of 809316?]. Ref: L-AB-7 [Grid reference is inaccurate as it plots north of the A3 road. SU809313 may be nearer and would at least be within Longmoor Airstrip]
Fleet Pond, Fleet	SU822553	19-Oct-07	One plant bearing 6 stems and still in flower at SU8228 5530 on turf-stripped area at west end of the dry heath area.
Fleet Pond	SU823552	08-Jul-97	Large plant bearing several flowering stems near west edge of Fleet Pond Dry Heath.
Fleet Pond	SU823553	04-Aug-07	One plant in flower at SU8237 5535 on heath near car park.
Fleet Pond	SU823553	05-Jul-06	Short turf near the railway fence, three plants in flower at SU8236 5535 (GPS).
Fleet Pond	SU823553	29-Apr-06	Short turf near the railway fence, five at SU8236 5536 and seven at SU8237 5535 (GPS), all rabbit-grazed.
Fleet Pond	SU824553	15-May-02	Three grazed rosettes in short turf at SU8243 5536 near the railway.

Aldershot Common	SU844506	11-Aug-08	Three plants scattered along dry grassy track margin several metres apart, SU8448 5065 to 8449 5067 to east of Brown Loaf Hill. (Seen here CRH in 1993, perhaps revived by grazing?)
Aldershot Common	SU844507	11-Aug-08	One plant on trackside at SU8447 5072, growing with Nardus, Danthonia and Filago minima. East of Brown Loaf Hill. (Seen here CRH in 1993, perhaps revived by grazing?)
Aldershot Common	SU844507	03-Jul-93	Beside sandy track NE of Brown Loaf Hill, 12 plants.
Aldershot Common	SU845507	22-Jul-12	One in flower on track side to east of Brown Loaf Hill. [Searched for unsuccessfully by Chris Hall on 6 Sep 2014].
Hawley	SU852593	15-May-98	Short mown turf in churchyard, between church and road, about 80 plants.
Hawley	SU857592	02-Aug-92	Dry heath on sandy railway embankment, absolutely abundant, the bank is blue with flowers. Colony extends c. 50 metres, growing with plentiful Erica cinerea and groups of Teesdalia. Shown to me by Steve Bailey.
Hawley Meadows	SU858590	10-Sep-10	Decreasing by the railway due to spread of bramble and increased shade from scrub/trees inside railway fence. 8 plants at SU8584 5909.

Farnborough Cemetery, Victoria Road	SU865558	31-Aug-11	About 35 in flower towards north end. Grass recently mown, no search made for non-flowering plants. 3 at SU8658 5583, 5 at SU8658 5582, 5 at SU8658 5580, 5 at SU8657 5585, 7 at SU8657 5580, 4 at SU8657 5582, 3 at SU8658 5584, 3 at SU8657 5586.

I have omitted some earlier records, or duplicates, with the same grid reference.

I used to know it at Fleet Pond but I am pretty sure it has been lost to scrub growth. The same is true at some other sites.
